

School Community Council Meeting Notes: January 19, 2021

2:10 pm Introductions & Notes Motions

Misty Wright motions to approve past notes. Seconded by Jennifer Bird. Notes Approved.

2:15 pm Questions and introduction of Mrs. Ford

No major questions for JoLynn. Reminder given that Mr. Call is in charge of Mustang Message.

2:16-2:30 pm Changes to Quarantine guidelines

New guidelines for school exposures. If both students were wearing masks correctly then students don't have to quarantine. School numbers have dropped sharply, and teachers are being quarantined. What types of activities will be able to be brought back to this year and next. How have grades been affected by COVID issues. More than usual for term 2, but we are working on corrections. We follow a pyramid of interventions that are to help various levels of students. Online deficiencies are tough, because we can only reach out through email and it has limited success. Will there be long term remediation? Perhaps on a district level? Ingenuity through Landmark has online remediation set up and high school students will be offered credit recovery packets. Will likely be opened up to 9th grade students. Utah Students Connect is another online option to help students catch up credits.

2:30-2:48 pm SCC goals

How might SCC help students make up their credits? Do we want to change our goals since everything is so unusual? Our usual metrics will be useless for last year, this year, and perhaps the following year.

Possible ideas for funds:

- Using funds to have an extra period of teachers/technicians working with students to make up high school credit.
- Technology goals to help student performance
- Extra class periods for math remediation (Tier 2)

Other end of the spectrum-How are we helping advanced students to continue to grow?

Could we address more differentiation in our support groups? Or SL&C teams?

Do we want to wait and put together more ideas of how to support students in the next year and following.

Would there be adjustments to our plan that could help with immediate needs?

Bottom line: Is there something we see a need for that we want to amend the plan?

Our current plan addresses all of the tiers, which is a good thing. Right now we are thinking about keeping the plan the same. We will need to tweak for numbers of students and amount of FTE. We are currently losing 100-120 fewer students next year. This is because of the move to middle school model and boundary changes.

After discussion, the final plan is to keep direction the same and have specific ideas for the February meeting.
