

## **School Community Council Meeting Notes: March 15, 2021**

### **2:20 pm Introductions & Notes Motions**

### **2:23 pm-2:45pm Counselors Update about Social Emotional Learning**

Counselors work with health teachers to help students learn about Social Emotional skills. They use a pre assessment survey to help find students who would benefit from DBT to increase resiliency. They use a post survey to show improvement in students who have experienced trauma and need help with coping skills. This has been an ongoing intervention and partnership with Wasatch Mental Health and Health teachers here at MJHS from 2017-2021. All students are receiving the general social emotional instruction, but those that are struggling may be referred by a teacher, administration, and or parents for the DBT course that are small group instruction from a social worker from Wasatch Mental Health and the school counselor. The presentation is happening in 8th and 9th grade health classes.

### **2:50 pm-3:00pm School Plan for 2021-22 year**

**Goal 1 is that student growth will increase by 1% point or more on the Utah State end of year assessments.**
