- Meeting called to order by co-chair (Patrick) at 3:00.
- Minutes from last meeting summarized by Patrick
 - No corrections from minutes
 - Nate motioned to approve minutes, Holly seconded, all in favor
- Three vacancies in committee, motion moved to approve Eric Wilson, Leah White, and Suzanne Jackman to fill those vacancies
 - Motion-Holly, 2nd-KayLynn, all in favor
- SCC Overview
 - Binders--information included and available to parents
 - Training available on Oct 11 at the District Office in the boardroom
 - Discussion on how School LAND Trust money can be used--academic purposes only
- Information for the Council
 - Report from Holly on the superintendent meeting
 - Student population growth in Nebo
 - 10% of students were evacuated during recent fires, many faculty members in district spent volunteer hours to help
 - Insurance increase, 5% salary increase, \$500 pay bonus, increase in base pay for teachers in the district
 - Looking to create a district health clinic
 - Bond--middle schools first, then order of new high school constructions will depend on need first and then a type of lottery if all found on equal need
 - Mustang Time Overview
 - Every Monday, teachers present a lesson to students in 2nd period about character ed or life skills seen as needed in the school. School would also like to hear from SCC members about any ideas or topics that they feel are needed or concerns based on what is heard in the community.
 - Previous lessons from this year: SafeUT app, resilience, peer pressure, stress
 - Prompted conversation about SafeUT app and how it can and has been used at the school
 - Review and Discussion 2018-2019 School Improvement Plan and associated budgets (Nate)
 - Putting 2018-2019 plan in action--only the things that take money are part of the School Trustlands plan
 - Last year: paid for 2 intern teachers and ½ FTE of a new teacher
 - Estimated to receive \$121,592 and actually received \$128,682

- Extra money may go towards more intervention or technology for classrooms
- Items from the Community
 - Question asked by Patrick about need for subs
 - Subs paid \$60-80 a day
 - Bad situation with lack of subs
 - If subs don't fill, school fills in by asking teachers to give up prep time to cover classes (\$20 compensation for each period covered)
 - If parents decide to sign up to be a sub, they can tell the system which schools/areas they are willing to work in and limit the days they work
 - Helpful even if someone only subs once a month
 - Question raised about if advertising is out to other areas or groups like college students or community center/communication/media
 - No other items
